#### **General Information**

## How to Pay

RICS charges a non-refundable administration fee of in disputes of £25000 or under, £60.00 inclusive of VAT (or £120 if paid by the applicant) to make an appointment of a mediator or in disputes of over £25000, £120



inclusive of VAT (or £240 if paid by the applicant) to make an appointment of a mediator. The fees are required to proceed with your application and are non-refundable.

Please **do not** send a payment with your application, on receipt of the application, DRS will begin processing and email you the DRS reference number for your case and request for payment of the application fee. This request will have the following payment options:

- A link to our online portal to make a secure online payment; or
- An option to complete a card payment by telephone through our secure automated process

Once we have received payment, we will start the process and your application will be formally acknowledged.

#### **Trade Accounts**

Our more frequent users may have an active trade account registered with us. If you have a trade account please supplied your account information, we will automatically raise an invoice, and this will be sent to you. **However,** please be aware that a quotation inviting you to pay online, or by telephone will also be despatched. For trade account applications only, we will start to proceed your application immediately.

#### **Your Privacy**

## **Explanatory notes:**

- RICS has a duty to act independently and transparently when appointing a dispute resolver. On receipt
  of a request, DRS will select a suitability qualified RICS Accredited Mediator who is free from conflicts of
  interest.
- It is vital that you complete all sections of the application form; incomplete sections may result in delays and an inappropriate nomination.
- As a matter of policy RICS may forward the information contained in an application form and supplementary documentation in the case details, to the trader in dispute and/or the representatives. Details of the case will also be sent to prospective mediators to help them decide whether they can or cannot take on the nomination.
- If the dispute is resolved before the mediator is nominated, you must notify RICS as soon as possible.
- RICS DRS acts in an administrative capacity and will make an appointment in accordance with your application
- Your application will be processed on the basis that that appointments are often made on behalf of the President/Chairman of RICS by one of his/her duly appointed agents.
- RICS DRS will not always seek comments from the parties on disclosures made by potential appointees. In some cases, the President/Chairman may decline to appoint someone, even if they are satisfied that the potential dispute resolver has no conflicts of interest. Before an appointment is made RICS DRS will take into account a range of factors including representations made by both parties.
