### Project Description:

Kwun Tong House, a testament to the RMHC's commitment to "Family-Centered Care," has been established in 2023 with generous funding from The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust. Strategically located near the Hong Kong Children's Hospital, Kwun Tong House aims to elevate the standard of care for families with sick children by providing comprehensive support and services.

The house boasts 66 guest rooms, designed with the comfort and needs of families in mind. Among these, 10 rooms are barrier-free and fully accessible to wheelchair users, ensuring inclusivity for all. Additionally, 6 special needs rooms are dedicated to post-bone marrow transplantation patients or children requiring specialized attention.

Beyond accommodations, Kwun Tong House offers a range of multi-purpose facilities and communal spaces, catering to the daily living and recreational needs of the families, further reinforcing RMHC's philosophy of putting families at the heart of care.
